ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW & STATISTICS

Mission: To relieve dental pain and suffering while preserving oral health through preventive education and comprehensive treatment for those with no other access to dental care.

Year to Date Value of Services Donated by the Donated Dental Program: \$572,363

Patient Numbers - Donated Dental Program

Total Number of Patient Visits: 428 **YTD: 1380**

- An average of 10 Donated patients were treated a day at SLDDS during the 3rd Quarter.
- SLDDS's volunteer dentists donated an average of **\$4,048 in services each day.**

Patient Numbers - Organization Wide

Total Number of Patient Visits: 824 **YTD: 3,612**

- An average of 23 patients were treated a day at SLDDS during the 3rd Quarter.
- Average cost to SLDDS per patient visit: \$154

Volunteer Hours – Donated Dental Program

Throughout the 3rd Quarter a dentist volunteered services at SLDDS **153%** of the clinic's operating hours. There were 467 hours volunteered by dentists, 66 hours by hygienists, and 16 hours by dental assistants and 7 general volunteers.

Total volunteer hours: 556 hours

Procedure Breakdown – BOTH Programs

Total Procedures: 4,347 **YTD: 12,735**

- **Preventative & Restorative Procedures: 73%**
- **Prosthetic Procedures: 8%**
- **Oral Surgery Procedures: 19%**
- Each patient received an average of \$424 in free services at each visit.
