ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW & STATISTICS

Mission: To relieve dental pain and suffering while preserving oral health through preventative education and comprehensive treatment for those with no other access to dental care.

Year to Date Value of Services Donated by the Donated Dental Program: \$337,121

Patient Numbers - Donated Dental Program

Total Number of Patient Visits: 169 **YTD: 687**

- An average of **3** Donated patients were treated a day at SLDDS during the 3rd Quarter.
- SLDDS's volunteer dentists donated an average of **\$1,554** in services each day.

Patient Numbers - Organization Wide

Total Number of Patient Visits: 984 **YTD: 2,728**

- An average of **19** patients were treated a day at SLDDS during the 3rd Quarter.
- Average cost to SLDDS per patient visit: **\$167**

Volunteer Hours – Donated Dental Program

Throughout the 3rd Quarter a dentist volunteered services at SLDDS **29%** of the clinic's operating hours. There were **105** hours volunteered by dentists, **7** hours by hygienists, and **31** hours by dental assistants and **12** general volunteers.

Total volunteer hours: 155 hours

Procedure Breakdown – BOTH Programs

Total Procedures: 3,520 **YTD: 10,055**

- **Preventative & Restorative Procedures: 73%**
- **Prosthetic Procedures: 12%**
- **Oral Surgery Procedures: 15%**
- Each patient received an average of \$474 in free services at each visit.
