Mission: To relieve dental pain and suffering while preserving oral health through preventive education and comprehensive treatment for those with no other access to dental care.

Year to Date Value of Donated Dental Program Services: \$156,501

Year to Date Value of Discounted Dental Program Services: \$101,691

Patient Numbers - Donated Dental Program

Total Number of Patient Visits: 278 **YTD: 278**

- An average of **6** donated patients were treated a day at SLDDS during the 1st Quarter.
- SLDDS's volunteer dentists donated an average of **\$3,220** *in services each day*.

Patient Numbers - Organization Wide

Total Number of Patient Visits: 1,104 **YTD: 1,104**

- Average cost to SLDDS per patient visit: **\$162**

Volunteer Hours – Donated Dental Program

Throughout the 1st Quarter a dentist volunteered services at SLDDS **97%** of the clinic's operating hours.

*There were **332** hours volunteered by dentists during the 1st Quarter.

Total volunteer hours: 499 hours

Procedure Breakdown – BOTH Programs

Total Procedures: 3,852 **YTD: 3,852**

- **Preventative & Restorative Procedures: 78%**
- **Prosthetic Procedures: 9%**
- **Extraction Procedures: 13%**
- Each patient received an average of **\$550** in free services at each visit.
